Château La Fleur Penin 2016 – Saint-Emilion Grand Cru - 88-89 pts

"The nose is fruity, structured and offers power. It reveals notes of cassis, wild berries and Cuban pepper associated with small touches of violet, blackberry as well as discreet hints of spice / cardamom and an imperceptible hint of blackcurrant bud. The palate is fruity, balanced, finely tight and offers smoothness, tension as well as a fine freshness. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of fleshy / juicy blackberry, juicy red berries and blackcurrant associated with fine hints of Zan, blond tobacco as well as discreet hints of blackcurrant bud and cardamom (in the background) . The tannins are slightly mellow. Chews at the end of the mouth. "
